RULES FOR VISITORS TO CHÂTEAU DE PRANGINS – SWISS NATIONAL MUSEUM

OUTDOOR AREAS

Welcome to Château de Prangins – Swiss National Museum.

We pride ourselves on offering our visitors and external service providers the highest level of safety and cleanliness. We therefore ask you to follow the rules set out below. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, they apply to the entire grounds (courtyard, café terrace, panoramic terrace on the lake side, kitchen garden, alleys and pathways in the park, the park itself, orchard, etc.).

- 1. All visitors to Château de Prangins are required to comply with these rules.
- 2. For security reasons, Château de Prangins is under video surveillance.
- 3. No vehicles of any kind (vans, cars, bicycles, scooters, etc.) may be parked in the courtyard or on the alleys in the park. Two-wheeled vehicles (bicycles, scooters) may use the dedicated parking area by the gates at the entrance to the château. Only vehicles for visitors with reduced mobility may enter the courtyard and stop there for a brief time to set down or pick up users.
- 4. Emergency doors (evacuation routes) must be kept clear at all times.
- 5. Visitors are requested to deposit rubbish (including cigarette butts, chewing gum, bottles, boxes, packaging of all kinds, etc.) in the bins provided.
- 6. Bill posting, advertising, distributing handouts, collecting signatures, photography or filming requiring a tripod or the like as well as all other forms of public use are prohibited without the express permission of museum management.
- 7. Sound equipment may not be used in the courtyard.
- 8. The kitchen garden is a conservation area and exhibition centre. Smoking is prohibited, as are dogs, with the exception of guide dogs.
- 9. Access to the courtyard and panoramic terrace is limited to the opening hours of the grounds, from 09.30 to 17.30 (except for special and/or private events).
- 10. Visitors must comply with the instructions of museum staff, gardeners and SECURITAS officers at Château de Prangins.
- 11. Violations of the rules may result in visitors being asked to leave the museum, or in prosecution or claims for damages. If you are asked to leave, the entrance fee will not be refunded.
